Bob Dean, K1 Touring, Veteran 2, 1st (2nd overall out of 11 finishers)
Dan Baumert, K1 Touring, Senior, 2nd (4th overall out of 11 finishers)

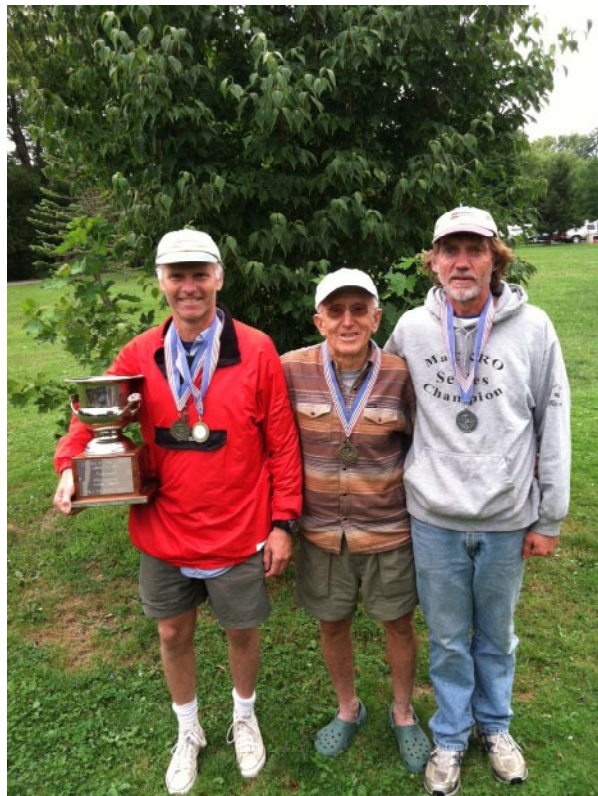
